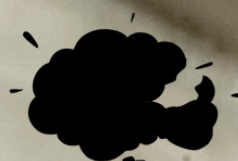

Introduction

The film tells the story of the three international co-creation events that took place in Luxembourg, Berlin and Lublin as part of the Empowering Creative Minds (ECM / EmpCreativeMinds) project while presenting the artworks produced (**D5.3**).

It combines three perspectives into one coherent picture: how creativity – conducted in a trauma-informed approach – can build security, strengthen agency and help establish relationships beyond language, history and migration experiences.

In Luxembourg (August 2025), the workshop organised by DOURI brought together artists from Germany, Poland, Ukraine and Luxembourg – and work with movement, drawing and sensory expression led to storytelling and a discussion about how film can convey the invisible effects of trauma. In Berlin, on the initiative of Comparative Research Network e.V. (September 2025), participants explored 'landscapes of trauma' in public spaces (including the East Side Gallery) and then turned their reflections into collaborative works: collages, zines and collective drawings. In Lublin (end of October 2025), in the safe space of Teatr Wschodni, the body, voice and rhythm became the centre of experience – from somatic practices, through work with breath and singing, to the collective pulse of drums as a 'language of encounter' where words fail.

The film was created by Kacper Pęczuła – filmmaker and member of the DLA ZIEMI Association.
